This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.155 dated 13.04.2016, under Sections 363/366-A IPC, registered at Police Station, Safidon, District Jind.

As per allegations in the FIR,Rajpati @ Kajal, daughter of complainant, had left her house by taking Rs.40,000/- and had accompanied the petitioner. In her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C (Annexure P-1), she had stated that she was a student of 10th Class and had gone to Ajmer along with the petitioner. She was recovered by the police from a hotel and was brought back to Safidon.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that after framing of charges, the trial is at the stage of recording of 21 prosecution witnesses. None of the witnesses has been examined so far.

The petitioner is in custody since 16.04.2016.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and

the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jind.
