Petitioner No.1 armed with 12 bore double barrel gun and petitioner No.2 armed with a 'sota' had allegedly assaulted complainant Gurbaaj Singh on account of dispute regarding installation of drainage pipes.

Through instant petition, petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail claiming that they have already joined investigation under the interim directions of this Court. It is an admitted fact that no grievous injury is attributed to the petitioners or any other accused.

There is a case of cross-version under Section 307 IPC also.

Petitioners have already joined investigation. In view of said circumstances, the petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioners, they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that they will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner and will not commit similar offence of which they are accused of during pendency of the trial.
