Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of order dated 4.10.2014 passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana (Annexure P-7), charge-sheet dated 4.10.2014 (Annexure P-8) and order dated 14.7.2015 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana (Annexure P-9) vide which the revision filed by the petitioner was dismissed.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that the aforesaid orders have been passed by the Courts below in case FIR No.461 dated 21.11.1999 under Sections 192, 195, 211, 464, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at

Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana.

Vide order of even date passed by this Court in connected petition i.e. **CRM-M-28463 of 2016** titled as ***Pritpal Singh Versus State of Punjab and another***, the aforementioned FIR with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom has been quashed qua the petitioner-accused Pritpal Singh on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
