Petitioners, Satender @ Kala and Vikas @ Vicky have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.119 dated 18.04.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Dadri, District Bhiwani, under Sections 25, 25-A, 54 and 59-A of Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Mr. B.S.Virk, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition. Police record has also been produced.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that one pistol .32 Bore along with three live cartridges was recovered from the possession of petitioner No.1 and further on the basis of his disclosure statement, one rifle, one live cartridge, one revolver and spare parts of the revolver were recovered and whereas from the custody of petitioner No.2-Vikas @ Vicky, four live cartridges were recovered. The petitioners have been in custody since 18.04.2016. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- each with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
