Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondents No.5 to 7, who are parents and another relative of petitioner No.2. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondents are not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and is extending threats to them. Copies of educational certificates of the petitioners (Annexure P-1 and P-2), copy of 'Aadhar' card of petitioner No.2 (Annexure P-3), copy of marriage certificate (Annexure P-4), marriage photographs (Annexure P-5) and copy of representation dated 08.08.2016 (Annexure P-6), have been placed on record.

Heard.

In view of above, Senior Superintendent of Police Tarn Taran-respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 08.08.2016, moved by the petitioners immediately, as per law. If respondent

No.2 is satisfied that there are actually threats to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then to take necessary steps to protect the petitioners from private respondents No.5 to 7, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
