This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.40 dated 21.05.2014 registered under Sections 21/22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Rangar Nagar, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner was regularly appearing in the Court and never misused the concession of bail but on one occasion he noted the wrong date and, therefore, could not appear.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from H.C. Rajinder Singh has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on the next date and the Court is directed to release him on bail to its satisfaction in case the assertion that the petitioner has not misused the concession of bail previously, is correct.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
