ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 139 dated 15.05.2015, registered at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari, under Sections 304-B and 328 read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is in custody since 10.09.2015 and the State has not been able to complete its evidence. It was urged that an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. was filed, which was dismissed and the husband was arrested and no suicide note was left.

The petitioner is the father-in-law. The girl was pursuing her Master's Degree. No suicide note was left. The prosecution has examined only ten witnesses out of seventeen. The trial is taking time. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
