The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 15 dated 12.02.2016 registered at Police Station Mansa City, District Mansa under Sections 406/420 IPC on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2 on the allegation that the complainant had paid a sum of Rs. 2 lacs for getting a job to the complainant. A promise was made that Rs. 3 lacs will be paid to the petitioner after the job is secured but the complainant was not selected.

Parties have entered into compromise. They were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate and get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been sent to the effect that matter has been compromised voluntarily. Copy of the compromise and statements have also been appended with the report.

I am satisfy with the report that the matter has been

compromised. As per the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *“Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) Recent Criminal Reports (P&H), 1052”*, the FIR can be quashed on the basis of compromise.

The petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
