In Case/Complaint No.211/1/2014 dated 13.11.2014 registered under Sections 504 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 Section 3(1)(x) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (prevention of Atrocities) Rules 1989 read with Section 120-B of 'IPC', the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as counsel for the complainant state that indeed there is a compromise (Annexure P-3) has been arrived at between the parties. This Court vide order dated September 19, 2016 had directed the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate to record the statements of the parties in view of the compromise and verify that whether the same is genuine or not.

Now, there is a report received from District and Sessions

Judge, Jalandhar, showing that the statements of the parties have been recorded and compromise that is arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

Looking to the terms of compromise (Annexure P-3), I think, parties should be allowed to compound/compromise the offences in order that they live in peace and harmony.

In that view of the matter, Case/Complaint No.211/1/2014 dated 13.11.2014 registered under Sections 504 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 Section 3(1)(x) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (prevention of Atrocities) Rules 1989 read with Section 120-B of 'IPC' is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
