Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.75 dated 01.06.2016, under Sections 384, 506, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur, petitioner was arrested on 02.06.2016 and is in Jail since then.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Bikkar Singh, stated that there is no similar offence against the petitioner. Petitioner is a woman having a child of 7 years of age. Learned State counsel further submits that the trial has commenced and 3 witnesses have been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that they are material witnesses.

In the light of the fact that the petitioner is a woman and further fact that there is no other offence to her credit, I am inclined to grant her bail.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/trial Court concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence or threaten the prosecution witnesses.
