This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.89 dated 11.05.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar, Karnal, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

On 16.08.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered on the basis of secret information to the effect that Bijender and Mukesh had prepared false documents for smuggling liquor illegally.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not named in the FIR but has been implicated on the basis of the statement of driver Bijender that money has been paid by the petitioner.

Notice to the Advocate General, Haryana, for 5.10.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the

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petitioner will join investigation on 27.8.2016 and 17.9.2016 or on any other day as required by the investigating agency. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mahinder Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he has been found innocent and is not required for further investigation.

In view of the statement, made by learned State counsel, the instant petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.
