DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner Vipin Goel, under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.2, dated 02.01.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, Police Station Women Cell Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties as both the petitioner and complainant have settled their dispute before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and now they are residing together.

Learned counsel appearing for complainant has also affirmed the factum of compromise. The petitioner as well as the complainant are present in Court today and have been identified by their respective counsel. A perusal of

compromise/settlement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the terms and conditions of the compromise signed by both the parties show that the parties have mutually agreed to withdraw all the cases. It was also settled that in the petition filed for quashing of FIR, other party will have no objection in quashing of the FIR and other proceedings arising therefrom.

On perusal of the compromise/settlement arrived at between the parties and after hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and complainant at length, the dispute has been settled and both the parties are residing together. The complainant has specifically stated that she has no objection in quashing the FIR and other proceedings arising therefrom. Moreover, it is a matrimonial dispute and both the parties have decided to remain together on the basis of settlement arrived at between them before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and no grouse is left against each other. The compromise arrived at between the parties is without any pressure from either side.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.02 dated 02.01.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell Ludhiana and other proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner namely Vipin Goel are hereby quashed.
