The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.27, dated 2.4.2016, registered under Sections 302, 120-B, 148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station City II, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody for more than four months and the only allegation is that he was accompanying the co-accused but no overt act has been attributed to him.

Brar, Deputy Superintendent, Sub Jail, Malerkotla, has been filed. As per the same, the petitioner has already undergone 4 months and 10 days in custody.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions of SI Jagdev Singh, has accepted the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
