Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 17.6.2016, on the allegation of being responsible for shortage of bags of wheat in the stock stored in PUNSUP Godown at Shahkot.

The petitioner was working as Inspector Grade-I in PUNSUP. Prima facie, it appears that he alone is not responsible for the alleged shortage.

Keeping the petitioner in custody during the entire period of trial will not serve any purpose. The recoveries, if any, could have been effected while police remand of the petitioner was obtained from the concerned Magistrate.

The petitioner in above circumstances can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner will be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
