Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The Court had declined to release the petitioners on bail as the evidence of the witnesses was not recorded before the Court. The petitioners in FIR No. 18, dated 23.02.2016 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 186, 188, 427 and 436 of the Indian Penal Code and 151 of the Railways Act and Section 4 of the PDPP Act have been in jail since 23.02.2016.

Now the depositions of the witnesses have been recorded who have turned hostile.

In that view of the matter I find no ground to keep the petitioners in jail. Hence the petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bhiwani.

Put up on 23.01.2017 for further consideration and for awaiting the affidavit of concerned DGP for compliance pursuant to orders dated 29.11.2016 and 02.12.2016 passed by this Court.
