Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Ranjit Singh in case FIR No.23 dated 30.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 302 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Dorangla.

As per the allegations the main accused Gurjant along with three other persons had gone in car and shot Prem Singh in broad day light in front of eye witness/complainant ASI Vijay Kumar.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Vijay Kumar submits that on interrogation of the main accused Gurjant Singh complicity of the three co-accused namely Ranjit Singh(present petitioner), Gurjit Singh and

Dilpreet Singh has surfaced.

All the three co-accused have evaded arrest and have since been declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 02.1.2016.

Counsel for the parties heard.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of offence and the name of the petitioner having surfaced in the investigation, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
