Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Sandeep Singh Bedi in case FIR No.91 dated 30.05.2015 for offence punishable under Section 406 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, District Amritsar City lodged by the wife.

Petitioner-accused and the complainant Rashmi were married in the year 2003 and there are two children born out of the said wedlock. As on today they are stated to be residing separately. Divorce proceedings have been initiated by the husband and are stated to be pending.

In the aforesaid FIR, allegations are that a Ford Fiesta Car

bearing no.PB-10-BF-7172 under the ownership of the complainant has been taken away by the husband. There are certain other documents also such as Voter I Card, Passport, Pan Card, Certificates, Blank Cheques etc which are not being returned by the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Rampal submits that although the petitioner has repeatedly joined investigation but has not returned the articles/car and hence uncooperative.

Keeping in view the nature of allegations and the aforesaid non-cooperative attitude of the petitioner, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
