Petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of the statement of co-accused Parveen Arora disclosing that the petitioner was in contact with her and he had been asking her to speed up the FSL reports and for getting desired reports, he had been collecting money from the concerned persons and would remit the same to her by depositing the amount in bank account. Though these allegations are serious against the petitioner but in view of the fact that the challan has already been presented and the petitioner being in custody with effect from July, 2016, he can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not leave India without the permission of the Court and he will not commit the similar offence of which he is accused of, in the present case, during the pendency of the trial.
