By filing the present petition, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought regular bail in FIR No. 03 dated 05.01.2015, registered under Sections 409, 403 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 18.03.2015. This is the 3rd petition filed on behalf of the petitioner. The second petition was dismissed by this Court with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within four months and on the request of the trial Court, the time was further extended to four months. The petitioner is behind the bars for indefinite period despite direction of this Court.

The learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

This is the 3rd bail petition filed by the petitioner. Earlier, the petitioner approached this Court by way of filing CRM-M-7926 of 2016, which was dismissed, vide order dated 10.03.2016. There is no fresh circumstances in favour of the petitioner, therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail.

Dismissed. .

The learned trial Court shall make an endeavour to conclude the trial within the period stipulated.
