Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated 13.4.2016, under Sections 21/22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that the alleged recovery is 110 grams of Amphetamine, whereas the FSL report suggest that it contains Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride salt, therefore, the case is implanted against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhraj Singh argued that as per FSL report, the contraband recovered from the petitioner

contains Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride salt.

In view of the report as received from the FSL, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.
