Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8.

As per the report/communication dated 21.09.2016 received from Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh, the statements of both the petitioners have been recorded to the effect that they do not have any threat perception from anyone and does not require any police protection.

Learned APP appearing for U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI-Amrit Pal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition, however, submits that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties.
