Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the parties have compromised the matter. Therefore, on the basis of compromise, the petitioners seek quashing of the FIR in question.

It comes out that it is a complaint case. The case is stated to be at pre-charge stage. The learned counsel for the petitioners states that the parties have compromised the matter.

In that eventuality, the complainant can always withdraw the said complaint and for the time being, there is no necessity to quash the same.
