Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 28.05.2014.

Though a period of more than two years has elapsed but only two witnesses appear to have been examined by the prosecution as per the information gathered from Head Constable Jaswinder Singh who is present in the Court along with the file.

The petitioner was allegedly found in possession of 50 grams of intoxicating powder containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride which is marginally higher than the commercial quantity prescribed.

Taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by the petitioner and the quantity alleged to have been recovered from him, he can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released

on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
