This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.331 dated 18.4.2016 registered for the offences under Sections 285 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act and (Sections 307 and 120-B IPC, which were added later on) at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Haryana.

Mr. Vikramjit Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR in the present case has been

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registered on the statement of Sunita wife of Joginder. A perusal of the FIR shows that Kamal Yadav was driving the motorcycle and one Sumit alias Kali was pillion rider and they fired towards the gate of the house of the complainant. The present petitioner has not been named in the FIR.

The petitioner has been in judicial custody since 28.4.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹35,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
