Present petition under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner is for cancellation of the regular bail granted to respondent No.2/accused-Mansha Ram by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rewari in case FIR No.39 dated 22.04.2011, under Sections 307, 120-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Sadar, Rewari.

At the time of hearing, learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Subhash Chand, submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the trial stands concluded and the accused have been acquitted, vide judgment dated 13.03.2012.
