Through instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 3, to register FIR against respondent No.4, in pursuance of complaint dated 30.05.2014 moved by him to Chowki Incharge, Panchkula.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. D.R. Singla, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though a complaint was lodged way-back on 30.05.2014 to Chowki Incharge, Panchkula and on 06.06.2014 to the DCP, Panchkula but till date no action has been taken.

5. The present petition is disposed of with the direction to Commissioner of Police, Panchkula-respondent No. 2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in complaint dated 30.05.2014 (Annexure P-2) and representation dated 06.06.2014 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
