By virtue of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the petitioner has sought pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.147 dated 14.07.2016 under Sections 307/435/341/323/336/506/427/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station City Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

At the time of issuance of notice of motion, on 17.08.2016, following order was passed by this Court, which reads as under :-

" Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.2-Karan Singh has been arrested. His prayer for anticipatory bail qua petitioner No.2 is therefore rejected and the petition qua him is dismissed.

In so far as petitioner No.1 Jarnail Singh is concerned, notice of motion to the respondent-State returnable on 30.09.2016.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim bail in FIR No.147 dated 14.07.2016, registered under Sections 307, 435, 341, 323, 336, 506, 427, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal code, 1860, at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, on furnishing of his bail bond amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount."

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh, has fairly submitted that in compliance of the order dated 17.08.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspect of the case and without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the order dated 17.08.2016 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute and shall enure during the pendency of the trial. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
