The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.27,
dated 2.4.2016, registered under Sections 307, 326, 324, 341, 323, 427,
148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Malaudh, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the petitioners
were attributed only simple injury and the injury under Section 307 of the

IPC was attributed to another co-accused who is in jail, and the

petitioners have now been in custody since 25.4.2016.

Learned DAG Punjab as well as counsel for the complainant have accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioners, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
