Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.3 to 5.

Prayer has also been made to direct respondent No.2 to carry fair and impartial investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jagbir Singh, states that in the present case, investigation has already been completed, Challan has been submitted in the Court and even charge-sheet has been framed against the accused.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition. However, he submits that the petitioner be given liberty to take all the possible pleas before the trial Court as available to him under law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
