Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested in FIR No.RC AC1 2016 A0003, dated 24.05.2016 for the offence punishable under Sections 120-B IPC and Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 on 25.05.2016 and since in jail.

Learned counsel for the respondent-CBI has opposed the bail to the petitioner on the ground that investigation has been completed but there is likelihood of the tampering or influencing the prosecution witnesses by various means.

I have perused the FIR.

The petitioner was accompanied with Ravinder Singla who is official in CBI. He was released on bail by order dated August 05, 2016. Prima facie, the petitioner is entitled to be released on bail as he was an accomplice. Hence he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Special Judge CBI, Chandigarh Court and the following conditions are imposed:-

1. The petitioner shall not tamper with the record or otherwise influence the prosecution witnesses independent or otherwise.

- 2. The petitioner shall not even visit the office of the complainant company or talk on telephone to its officers and keep himself away from the officers of the complainant company and witnesses;
- 3. The respondent-CBI will be at liberty to apply for cancellation of bail in case of any further commission of such type of offence by the petitioner.
