The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.307, dated 20.5.2016, registered under Sections 419, 420, 336 of the IPC, Sections 2(d), 3, 4, 5 of the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act and Section 15(2) and 15(3) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Allegations are that the petitioner was practising as

allopathic doctor without a valid degree.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 20.5.2016 and the trial is nowhere near conclusion.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Chander, has accepted the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
