This is a petition under section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.132 dated 27.12.2014, registered against the petitioners under sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated September 22, 2015, it was directed that petitioner would place the compromise deed on record. Same has not been done till now. Besides, allegations in the FIR are serious. One Harpreet Singh working as Helper in Kailash Hospital, Anandpur Sahib, stated before the police that on 22.12.2014 at about 9.45 P.M., he alongwith Vinod Kumar Helper and Monika Nurse was present on duty at the reception of the hospital. In the meantime, a swift car stopped outside the hospital. Three Hindu gentlemen and one Sikh boy, two of them were Jassi and Soni, entered the hospital, whereas driver remained inside the

car. Accused Jassi was having a pistol in his hand. He threatened complainant that they would kill him for helping Dr. Soni. He fired a shot with pistol at him. In order to save himself, complainant climbed stairs and escaped. The gunshot struck the roof of the door of the hospital. All the four boys then fled from the spot in their car. Statement of the complainant was supported by Vinod Kumar and Sunny Khanna.

Pursuant to FIR, investigation ensued. In my considered view, the matter needs to be taken to its logical end. Thus, no case for quashing of the FIR is made out.

Dismissed.
