The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.118, dated 9.4.2016, registered under Sections 21, 22, 29, 61, 85 of
the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Barnala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was
not arrested from the spot.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI

Kulwant Singh, has countered this by arguing that there is another case

registered against the petitioner and her four family members were arrested with the contraband.

Be that as it may, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 7.9.2016 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires her presence, and in the event of her arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
