The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.150, dated 30.6.2016, registered under Sections 379, 328, 34 of the IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody since 17.7.2016 and there is no allegation that he actually perpetrated the crime for which the present FIR has been registered. Allegation against him is that the main accused used to get

sedatives from his medical shop.

Learned DAG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Major Gir has accepted the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
