The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.52 dated 20.03.2015 registered under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act registered under Section 18-A/18-C of Drug and Cosmetic Act, 1940 and Section 420 IPC at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Kumar, submits that all the PWs have been examined and the judgment is likely to be delivered within one month.

In that view of the matter, I think the petitioner is entitled to the concession of regular bail.
