ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 84 dated 21.07.2015 registered at Police Station Women, Ludhiana under Sections 406/498-A/420-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that recovery of gold has not been effected which is to the tune of Rs. 10 lacs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had returned the articles whatever were with him and he was still ready to furnish guarantee before the trial Court and according to him it was not more than Rs. 7 lacs.

Learned State counsel submits that custodial interrogation is not required.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 07.09.2015 staying the arrest of petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and will deposit Rs. 7 lacs before the trial Court. It will be paid only after the decision of case and its fate. The trial Court will get the amount deposited in the form of FDR in a Nationalized Bank so that it earns interest and in the name of the Court.
