Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.47 dated 14.8.2015, under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C, 489-D of IPC, Sections 15, 18, 22, 21, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, Section 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act and Section 14 Foreigners Act, 1946, Sections 3 of Indian Passport Act and Section 3 of Official Secrets Act, 1923, registered at Police Station Sarai Amant Khan, District Amritsar City.

This Court vide order dated 19.8.2016, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid

down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Since the petitioners have not joined the investigation thereafter vide orders dated 22.8.2016 and 5.10.2016 they were again directed to appear before the investigating officer to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 5.10.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Hardeep Singh, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 19.8.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
