Pursuant to the order dated 19.08.2016, petitioner No.2 has filed an affidavit stating that he is Muslim by religion and he has got married to petitioner No.1.

C.R.M-M No.28538 of 2016

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of

respondent Nos.4 and 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record affidavit (Annexure P-1) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1997 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 01.01.1995 They have also moved a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Mewat (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertng to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- the Superintendent of Police, Mewat to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
