Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.32 dated 13.04.2016, registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala, under Sections 307, 323, 332, 353 and 186 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 333 IPC (which was added later on in the charge-sheet).

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Ms. Shivali, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and gone through the record. Police record has been produced.

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As per the allegations in the FIR, a tractor was driven by co-accused and the present petitioner was sitting on the side of the tractor. When the police party tried to stop the tractor, the co-accused while bringing it at a high speed, rammed it into the complainant, a police official, who received some injuries. However, none of the injuries has been declared grievous to life. The present petitioner was not driving the tractor.

The present petitioner has been in custody since 13.04.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The challan has already been presented against the present petitioner and trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
