By way of present petition, the petitioner has laid the challenge to order dated 20.05.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, SBS Nagar vide which complaint No.1702369/2011 031700031592009 titled as 'ICICI Bank Ltd. Vs. M/s Raja Di Hatti and another', filed by the respondent-Bank, has been transferred to the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, states that the respondent has no objection if the present petition is allowed and the matter is sent back to the competent Court at SBS Nagar.

Heard.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the respondent, the instant petition is allowed; the order dated 20.05.2016 (Annexure P-6) is hereby set aside and the matter is transferred back to competent Court at SBS Nagar. Considering the fact that the matter pertains to the year 2009 and cheque in question was issued on 21.07.2009, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
