FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 21.12.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Piara Singh, Harwinder Singh, Baljinder Kaur @ Balwinder Kaur, Santosh Kaur and Kamaljit Kaur as well as of complainant Manjit Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that offences are not heinous in nature and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, criminal complaint No.

220/1/2011 titled as Manjit Kaur vs. Piara Singh and others under Sections 323,324,326,148,149 IPC Police Station, Bhogpur, District Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
