Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate action against respondents No.4 to 5 and its officials and hired goons, for forcibly taking away Tata LPT 1109 bearing No. HR 37-B 5468 of the petitioner and later on sold the same without informing the petitioner by showing it as Jeep 207.

Learned counsel for the petitioner only prays for the relief that the representation dated 25.08.2015 (Annexure P-3), moved to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, by the petitioner-Mohinder Singh, be considered and he does not press the other relief asked in this petition.

In view of above, respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to look into the said representation (Annexure P-3) and pass appropriate order within two months, as per law, after receiving the certified copy of this order.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
