Learned counsel for the State has produced the affidavit of AIG, Security, Punjab, Chandigarh, on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 5, which is taken on record. The copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State while referring to the above affidavit submits that the instructions, (Annexure R-1) attached with the affidavit, have been issued by Additional Director General of Police, Security, Punjab, Chandigarh, on 18.02.2016, to maintain the law and order in the State; for safety of an individual and his property and that no harm is caused to

anyone. It has further been directed to ensure that no individual or transporter is harassed by any Truck Union operators. It has also been ordered that if any case of assault or physical force on the part of errant party is reported, then legal action should be ensured and the Office of Director General of Police, may also be informed immediately.

In view of the above instructions/directions, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage.
