Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Rajesh Kumar alleging that the petitioner along with 5-6 other persons had come in a truck and entered the company of the complainant and threatened the complainant by showing iron rods and knives. The complainant was asked to remain quiet and iron was loaded from the company of the complainant.

So far as the petitioner is concerned he has not been named in the FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused of the petitioner in the same FIR were acquitted by the trial court. The petitioner has been arrested on 15.06.2015.

In view of the fact that the co-accused of the petitioner have been acquitted and the petitioner is made to face trial on the basis of supplementary challan presented against him, he can be granted the concession of regular bail when he has not till date been declared a proclaimed offender.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate Rewari.
