By virtue of this petition preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner has sought bail in case FIR No. 309 dated 19.07.2016 under Section 279, 337, 338, 427 IPC (Section 304 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

Undisputably, petitioner was not driving the vehicle in question at the time of alleged accident and he was co-driver/helper. The driver of the vehicle has already been in custody and cooling his heels behind the bars. Petitioner was arrested in this case on 19.07.2016 and since then he is suffering incarceration. The presentation of challan and disposal thereof, would take sufficient long time.

Taking into consideration the afore-said aspects but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
