This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 17.07.2016, registered under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC and under Section 13 of the Punjab Gambling Act, P.S. Zira, District Ferozepur.

On 19.08.2016 the following order was passed:-

indulged in gambling on cricket matches during May 2016 and cheated the complainant.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab for 19.10.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on 27.08.2016 and 17.09.2016 or on any other day as required by the investigating officer. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from the Head Constable Bagh Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, I see no reason to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 19.08.2016 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
