Counsel for the applicant/respondents has submitted that dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise and the documents R-1, R-2 and R-3 but actually these are Annexures R2/1, R2/2 and R2/3 may be taken on record and the appeal may be disposed of in terms of compromise/mutual decision dated 15.03.2016 (Annexures R2/1).
