Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No. 54, dated 01.10.2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 427 read with Section 34, IPC, registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur,

submits that in compliance of the interim directions issued by this Court on 27.01.2016, the petitioner did join the investigation and no more required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim directions dated 27.01.2016, are made absolute.

The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.
