JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 258, dated May 12, 2012, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines, District Hisar (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-2**).

2. In compliance of order dated February 11, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Hisar, has been

received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise without any pressure or coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 258, dated May 12, 2012, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines, District Hisar (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners. However, it shall be obligatory on the part of the parties to the compromise to comply with the terms and conditions thereof. Otherwise, an aggrieved party shall have the liberty to approach this Court again to challenge this order/judgment.
