A report has been received which indicates that petitioner had absented on 09.10.2013 resulting in cancellation of his bail bonds/surety bonds but subsequently, he being in custody in another case under Section 307 IPC registered at Police Station, Ludhiana, he was not able to appear in the Court. The petitioner has been in custody with effect from 18.05.2016.

On the instructions of ASI Narender Singh, it has been informed that only one witness could be examined during the period of his detention after 18.05.2016. The period of detention suffered by the petitioner, in my opinion, will certainly have a deterrent affect upon him not to jump bail again.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released

on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. However, a direction is issued to the trial Court to dispose of the matter expeditiously.
